Under the Alabama Open Records Act and in compliance with Macon County Public Records policy and Alabama Supreme Court rulings pertaining to the County's obligation to provide business documents to the public, I am requesting county documents as related to its grants and other sources of revenue from federal and state government and agencies related to Covid, and its county-wide distribution(s) of financial assistance to present.

The requested documents, include but not limited to, copies of letters, invoices, and other documents related to such monies from all sources, and a typed list of county-wide organizations, businesses, and governmental and governmental subdivisions which received Covid and related grant monies, the organization, businesses, and governmental and governmental subdivisions' representative's name, the date(s) and amount(s) of money disbursed to the corresponding organization, businesses, and governmental and governmental subdivision, and the names of persons making the determination to which organization, businesses, and governmental and governmental subdivision would receive grant financial assistance.

Because this request will not fit on the County Public Records Request Form, I have taken the liberty to attach this written request.
