Federal Aid Project(s)

- County Road 40: Resurfacing project is complete.
- County Road 13: Work begins this week.
- Tysonville Loop and Road: Paperwork has already begun. \$380 K \$ need for project
- Old Montgomery Road: Plan work has been submitted by Krebs to ALDOT
- East Main Street: Plans have been reviewed by ALDOT with last review taking place this week. NOTASU19A
- County Road 2: Paperwork is complete with Planwork ready to go to ALDOT.

HRRR (High Risk Rural Roads) Project

- Project is complete. We are waiting on ALDOT review and acceptance.

Association of County Commissions of Alabama

- The Self-Insurance Fund is sponsoring a safety incentive for all counties. I have been trained as a coordinator to run the driving simulator which four of our deputies and nine of our crew members will go thru the simulator to improve their driving skills on Wednesday, July 10, 2013 and Monday, July 15, 2013.
